## TRAVEL DIRECTIONS

Fairfield is on highway 20 about 57 miles east of Mountain Home. When you arrive in Fairfield, turn north on Soldier Road (the paved road that goes through the business part of town). Go two miles to the stop sign, turn right, go about a quarter mile and turn left which puts you back on Soldier Road. Continue about 3 miles. You'll see the sign over our driveway and flags flying on the left side of the road.

Check-in time is between 4:00 and 5:00pm on Sunday (Sunday also for grades 2-3). Checkout time is about 10:00am on Saturday (Tues. for 2-3)



## FOR PARENTS

This information is intended to help you better understand the camp that your child(ren) will be attending.

### The Philosophy of the Camp

1. To provide a positive camp experience where Christ is lifted as Savior & Lord.
2. To install biblical truth and principles into the lives of our youth through a curriculum centered in the Word of God.
3. To create opportunities where decisions for Christ are made and/or deepened.
4. To develop an atmosphere for building of Christian relationships through truth and love.

The Camps are limited to 100 campers. We take registrations on a first-come basis. All the Christian Churches & Churches of Christ in the area have registration forms for you to fill out and return to the church along with the registration fee. The church will then send all the Registration forms and one check to the camp. This simplifies the bookkeeping. If for any reason your child cannot attend, a 100% refund will be given prior to 1 week of camp, there after a 50 % refund.

It is important for each child to attend the camp designated for his age group. The curriculum has been geared for those particular grades and the camper will feel more comfortable with his peers.

We ask that you do not visit or call your child during the week as this disrupts the flow of the program. However, we encourage you to write cards or letters, addressed to the camper, c/o ICC, RT 1Box 1283, Fairfield ID 83327. Please do not send candy or other food to your child. He cannot have it in his cabin, as it is an invitation to the rodents. Your child is served three nutritious, well-balanced meals a day plus a snack in the evening.

### An Opportunity to Serve

If God is nudging you to be a worker at the camp and you are at least four years older than the campers, contact the director of the camp in which you wish to work. Let your desire be known. You will have to meet certain requirements and be approved, have a background check, and fit in with the other workers- -this is a team effort. Everyone has a specific job to do with instructions on how best to accomplish it.
